ColourStar — Commercially Laundered Process

ColourStar is a rubber backed mat and can be commercially laundered.

- a. Flush for 2-3 minutes, medium water level, 49°C
- b. Break 5-10 minutes, high water level, 49°C
- c. Rinse 2 minutes, high water level, cold
- d. Extract (low speed) 1-2 minutes
- e. Shake out (rotate wheel at wash speed with drain open) 1-2 minutes
- f. Extract (high speed max 250 Gs) 3-5 minutes
- g. Dry 5-10 minutes, 82°C basket temperature
- h. Cool down 5 minutes
- i. Lay mats flat following removal from washer or dryer. Allow to cool before rolling
 - For heavy soil mats, increase temperature to max 60 °C
 - Break shouldn't exceed pH of 9.5; use low pH non-ionic detergents
 - Do not over-dry mats
 - Basket temperature of dryer should not exceed 82 °C
 - If mats are not dried, final rinse can be increased to 60 °C. This will reduce moisture retention following extraction

ColourStar - Regular Maintenance

- 1. Vacuum daily in high traffic areas. Vacuum weekly in lower-traffic applications.
- 2. Clean with an extractor or hose off as necessary to remove heavy soil. Hang to dry.
- 3. Mats should always be completely dry before they are placed back in service.

ColourStar - Storage and Handling

- Roll the mat in a compact roll with pile facing out. Lay flat. Do not crush. Store in a moderate temperature and dry area. CAUTION: if the borders on matting become broken or curled, the mat should be removing from service until the tripping hazard can be corrected
- Matting must never be stored on-end. This will cause the edges to curl and will void warranty. For proper storage, roll mat with top surface to the outside and lay flat in a protected area. Do not stack any materials or other mat on top of a stored mat.
